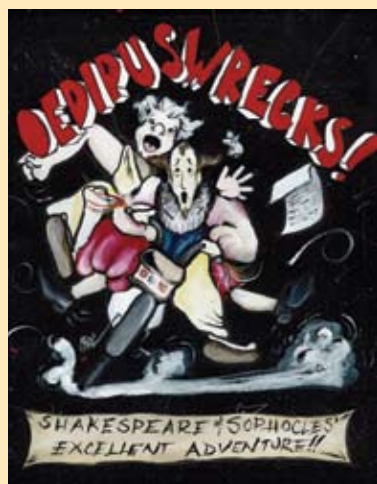

Former dean dies

John C. Downey, former graduate dean at the University of Northern Iowa, died Feb. 20, 2005, in Sarasota, Fla. He was 78.

President Maucker dies

J.W. "Bill" Maucker, UNI's president for two decades, died Tuesday, July 5, at Sartori Memorial Hospital in Cedar Falls. He was 92.



Born in Rock Island, Ill., September 16, 1912, Maucker was a 1933 graduate of Augustana College. He received his master of arts degree in 1936 and a Ph.D. degree in 1940, both from the University of Iowa.

Maucker served in the St. Louis and Pittsburgh public schools, the University of Missouri and Montana State University, the U.S. Office of Education in Washington, D.C., and in the U.S. Navy Bureau of Navy Personnel before becoming the fifth president of UNI (then Iowa State Teachers College) in 1950.

During his tenure, the college's emphasis changed from strictly teacher education to degrees in the liberal and vocational arts. The University Union was named the J.W. Maucker University Union in his honor in 1974.

Maucker is survived by his second wife, Doreen Weber Maucker; a daughter Ann M. King; and two sons, James and Robert. Maucker was preceded in death by his wife, Helga.
